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#### **Classroom Procedures**

#### What is this class about?



### Ways to help your student succeed

- # 1. Make sure your student comes to school prepared and ready to learn
- # 2. Remind your students to complete their homework (you can even watch it with them!) & study for tests and quizzes

  - # 4. Regularly check your students grades to hold them accountable on Parent Portal

Late Homework and Corrections:

Late homework (for any reason) is the responsibility of the student. You will need to get the homework assignment from me or another student. Once you have it done, you will need to come in and correct it in my room either before or after school. It needs to be done in a timely manner.

Quiz/Test Corrections are a way for you to earn back half of the points lost. They need to be done in my room before or after school. They will be done in pencil on a separate sheet of paper, which will be stapled to the original test. This is a great opportunity to earn points and to learn from your mistakes.
